Using BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC

This document explains basic operation of BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC (subsequently referred to as "TONE STUDIO").

This software has the following functionality.

- Directly access the BOSS TONE CENTRAL website and download track sets
- Transfer WAV files between the RC series unit (subsequently called the RC unit) and your computer

Installing TONE STUDIO

Windows users

- Double-click the "BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC Setup.exe" that you downloaded. Installation begins.
- 2. Proceed with installation as directed by the instructions appearing on the screen.
- When the screen indicates "Completing the BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC Setup Wizard," click the [Finish] button.

Mac users

- Double-click the "BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC.pkg" that you downloaded. Installation begins.
- 2. Proceed with installation as directed by the instructions appearing on the screen.
- 3. When the screen indicates "The installation was successful," click the [Close] button.

Uninstalling TONE STUDIO

Windows 10 users

- 1. Open Settings.
- 2. Click [Apps].
- 3. Click [BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC] in the installed app list.
- 4. Click [Uninstall].

Windows 8.1 users

- 1. Open the Control Panel.
- 2. Click [Uninstall Program] or [Programs and Functions].
- 3. Double-click [BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC].

Mac users

- 1. In the Finder, click the [Applications] folder.
- 2. Click the [BOSS] folder.
- 3. Click the [RC] folder.
- 4. Drag and drop the "BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC" into the trash.

Starting the software and connecting to the RC unit

Windows users

- 1. Turn on the power of the RC unit.
- 2. On models such as the RC-300 or RC-505 that have a USB mode switch, set USB MODE to "STORAGE."
- 3. Use a USB cable to connect the RC unit to your computer. For details on making the connection, refer to "Connecting to Your Computer via USB" in the owner's manual of the RC unit.
- 4. Double-click the BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC icon.

Mac users

- 1. Turn on the power of the RC unit.
- 2. On models such as the RC-300 or RC-505 that have a USB mode switch, set USB MODE to "STORAGE."
- 3. Use a USB cable to connect the RC unit to your computer. For details on making the connection, refer to "Connecting to Your Computer via USB" in the owner's manual of the RC unit
- 4. In the Finder, click the [Applications] folder.
- 5. Click the [BOSS] folder.
- 6. Click the [RC] folder.
- 7. Double-click the BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC icon.

Disconnecting the RC unit (Ejecting the USB drive)

1. Click the [Disconnect] button.

The "Disconnect" dialog box appears.

- 2. Click the [OK] button.
- 3. Disconnect the USB cable that connects the RC unit to your computer.
- 4. As described in "Ejecting the USB drive" in "Connecting to your computer via USB" in the owner's manual of the RC unit, perform the appropriate operations on your unit to stop the connection.

Downloading a track set

- 1. In the Track Sets column in the left of the screen, select the track set that you want.
- 2. In the Information column in the right of the screen, click the [Download] button for the sound you want.

The "Download" dialog box appears.

- 3. Click on the memory number of the RC's memory on which you want to save the downloaded sound.
- 4. Click the [Download] button.

The download begins.

- 5. If there are other sounds that you need, repeat steps 1--4.
- 6. When you have finished, disconnect the RC unit.

Explanation of other functions

Import

WAV files saved on your computer can be imported to the RC unit.

- 1. Click the [Import] button.
- 2. Select the WAV file that you want to import.

The "Import" dialog box appears.

- 3. Click on the track of the RC's memory on which you want to save the imported WAV file.
- 4. Click the [Import] button.

If there is already a WAV file on the track, it cannot be imported to that track. First, delete the file by clicking the [Delete] button.

Importable WAV file formats

- Data format: WAV (stereo/mono, PCM)
- Bit depth: 16-bit, 24-bit, 32-bit floating
- Sampling frequency: 44.1 kHz

Export

Phrases saved on the RC unit can be transferred to your connected computer.

1. Click the [Export] button.

The "Export" dialog box appears.

2. Click on the track of the RC's memory containing the sound you want to export.

The file format can be selected for RC-5 and RC-500.

- 3. Click the [Export] button.
- 4. Specify the transfer-destination folder and file name.
- 5. Click the [Save] button.

About

Displays various information about BOSS TONE STUDIO for RC.

Download/Import/Export dialog box functions

You can audition or delete track phrases.

Play/Stop

- 1. Click a track of the Memory that you want to audition.
- 2. Click the [Play] button.

The sound of the phrase is heard from your computer.

3. When you have finished auditioning the phrase, click the [Stop] button.

Delete

- 1. Click the track of the Memory that you want to delete.
- 2. Click the [Delete] button.

The "Confirm Delete" dialog box appears.

3. Click the [OK] button.
